- ⇒ **College Search:** Narrowing down your list by major, interest, location, school size and type
- ⇒ **Application Tracking:** Organizing colleges into columns- Not Interested, Interested, Applying and Applied
- ⇒ **Virtual Tours:** Visit colleges from your computer
- ⇒ **Scattergrams:** A visual tool to see the application outcomes of students from AHS

Invite Parents

Once the student registers for their Scoir account, they should click on the **Profile** tab. This is where they will see a link to **Invite Parents.**

Students will input their parent's name and email address to invite them!

Activate Your Scoir Account

- Find the email from Scoir with the subject line “**Introducing Scoir!**”
- Click “**Sign Up Now!**”
- On the welcome page, create a **password** for your Scoir accounts. Click on the box that states they are over 13, and click on the box that says, “I’m not a robot.” Then click on “**Sign Up.**”
- Once logged into Scoir, you will be prompted to answer a few questions. While these questions are optional, the answers will help you find colleges that will fit your personal and academic interests.
- Click “**Got it,**” and you can begin using the platform.
