The following questions came up during our Q & A session last week:

Will students be given Chromebook and other books for grade 6 when they go for WEB on Monday?

Students picking up Chromebooks will do so on Monday.

Are kids going to carry bags all day? Will they be carrying everything- textbooks, notebooks etc?

Students will keep their bags with them all day with computers and any folders they may have. Text books will go home and stay home. (If they are not digital)

The supplies list is the one on your web or is different?

The supply list on the web site is not current. Teachers will let students know what they need as we get started. Only computers to start.

Can we switch cohorts to allow our kids to be in the same cohort? If so, what is the process to do so?

Due to the numbers – cohorts cannot be switched at this time.

Will 6th graders have access to email?

Yes

Could you clarify what does synchronous and asynchronous learning mean?

Synchronous means the teacher is facilitating the class in real time. Asynchronous means that the teacher has provided the class with directions and activities but is not present for these activities.

How many students will be in the classroom with the teacher?

In academic classrooms there is a limit of 12 students

Will remote students have teachers separate from those teachers who teach in-person?

The Remote Team is a team of separate academic and World Language teachers. The Integrated Arts & PE teachers are shared between the hybrid and remote teams.

Are there color groups as in the past and are students changing classes or are teachers moving instead?

There are color groups which students will stay with and students will move according to a planned path to minimize contact throughout the building. Students will be provided with materials to clean their work surface before moving to their next class.

What is the split between Synchronous and Asynchronous will be for the remote academy students?

Remote Academy will have both synchronous core academic and WL opportunities (as well as any other services) and IA & PE will be asynchronous.

How many students in 6th grade are remote? And are they all considered in the same class?

About ¼ of each grade is remote. Each grade has one remote team, but students are in two groups per team.

Could you talk more about how the classroom teachers are balancing their kids at home during the at-home days while they are teaching the in-school group? Are the at-home days, are they patching into class or are they doing all asynchronous learning on those days? During the Asynchronous classes would there be some Q&A support if needed?

On hybrid remote days students will have asynchronous learning where teacher has provided the class with directions and activities but is not present for these activities. There will be some structure for questions/check-in which will be communicated once all schedules are confirmed.

Can remote kids can switch back to hybrid in next quarter if they want?

Switches from remote to hybrid will be considered at the end of the trimester and will be dependent on space in the hybrid program.

Are they just using Schoology and Google Classroom or just Schoology?

If classes are still in Google Classroom, will the to-do lists and assignments due be visible in Schoology?

It has been presented as being our and the students' one-stop-shop for what's due and all info about their courses. But it seems like Google Classroom is still in place. How does this work?

Many teachers are excited to use Schoology – but until they are comfortable with the format and we know it is fully functional, many teachers will be using Google Classroom. We are working hard to make sure all the information for a class, no matter the format, is easier for parents to access.

How will tests be given for hybrid students? Only on in-person days?

Determined by teachers – could be either depending on the type of assessment.

In the unfortunate event of an unplanned pivot to all remote will the teachers keep their kids.

What would happen so these kids don't miss a beat. (Having already missed 10 days of school)

In the event of all remote learning for the hybrid students, the teachers and teams will continue as they are. There may be slight adjustments to the schedule if this changes.

During in-person days, what time can kids be dropped at the earliest and where do they go? Cafeteria or their first class?

No students allowed in building before 7:30 and they will go to their first class.

Will students still have web leaders on Friday for remote?

WEB leaders will be working with their groups throughout the year on Wednesdays.

How will breakfast and lunch be provided for remote students?

The district will have a weekly pickup at one or two sites. More information to follow.

Please throw some light on Band choice and class schedule.

Band, Orchestra, and Chorus will only happen in a student's schedule (for the hybrid students) when they are on a hybrid **home** day. If a student is in school on a BOC day, they will have a Flex time. There may be additional scheduled time in the afternoons on Wednesday Remote.

How will kids get access to social workers - Ms Casey or Ms. Hillary?

They can email or let a teacher know, parents can email directly, and they will be making themselves very visible and present in the first few weeks.

Will the clubs still be running?

Very hopeful – will take a few weeks and likely virtual...

Will the schedules be in the family or student portal?

Will seats in each classroom be pre-assigned to kids??
